

# Help for School-Age Children & Youth

Under federal law, students in temporary living situations have educational rights.

## Who

- Families sharing housing due to economic hardship and loss of housing.
- Families living in motels, substandard housing and other temporary situations.
- Teens living temporarily without a parent or guardian.

## Services

Assistance with immediate school enrollment, transportation to stay in school even if you move out of district (as long as it's in the student's best interest), supplies, clothing, school-related expenses, credit recovery, housing crisis and other referrals, and general support for school success.
