Ford Early Learning Center is home to our Spanish Immersion program. This unique program currently starts in kindergarten with a grade level added each year. Students are immersed in the Spanish language for 90% of their instructional time. As students move through the program, English instruction increases and students become bilingual and biliterate. Native English speakers as well as native Spanish speakers are encouraged to apply. This is one of only 2 programs of its kind in Washtenaw county.
