EMU Bright Futures after school programs provide academically rich programming including targeted academic assistance, mentoring, and positive youth development experiences to students attending Ypsilanti Community Schools including Ypsilanti Community Schools Middle School, Washtenaw International Middle Academy, Ypsilanti Community High School, and Ypsilanti New Tech High School. Bright Futures is designed to address the needs expressed by the families and children to be served, community stakeholders, and school staffs.

EMU Bright Futures programs meet after school for three hours Monday through Thursday, 32 weeks during the school year and 6 weeks in the summer. Students participate daily in homework help and tutoring as well as attending a variety of clubs and activities. Clubs integrate writing skills, personal development, and specific skills to support a successful transition from elementary to middle and from middle to high school.
