Good Evening Grizzlies!

As you may have learned from Monday's Board of Education meeting, we continue to review the multiple factors to make a safe return to school decision for students and staff and have made several changes. We have provided below the tentative outline of significant dates to remember:

We will continue to address the (3) learning modes of instruction as we have all year; please refer to your particular group for your specific return dates. Further details are forthcoming by your building administrators.

In-Person- Those students/staff who began in September at YCES/Estabrook and YCMS

Remote- Those students/staff who have been in the remote to return in-person option

Online- Those students/staff who chose to remain online all year

Tuesday, January 19, 2021 - In-person **Staff** return to school

Preschool/Head Start - Remain remote.

Grades TK-1 - Return to their originally assigned buildings (Home buildings)

Grades 2-5 - Remain at Estabrook - These staff will remain with their (Learning Option Team - L.O.T.)

Grades 6-8 - Report on Monday & Tuesday at YCMS (Continue your previous schedule)

Grades 9-12 - Report on Wednesday & Thursday at YCMS (Continue your previous schedule)

Monday, January 25, 2021 - All **In-person students** return to the in-person school option. All In-Person students in grades 6-12 return to YCMS, 2-5 at Estabrook and TK-1 in the buildings with the teacher they have been with all year.

Monday, February 15, 2021 - All **Remote staff** will return to their assigned classrooms

Preschool/Head Start - Return to their originally assigned buildings (Home buildings)

Grades TK-1 - Return to their originally assigned buildings (Home buildings)

Grades 2-5 - Return to your originally assigned buildings (Home buildings)

Grades 6-8 - Continue your previous schedule, Monday through Thursday at YCMS

Grades 9-12 -Continue your previous schedule, Monday through Thursday at YCHS (remote staff only)

** Meaningful work assignments should be reviewed and communicated by your administrator or supervisor.

Monday, March 1, 2021 - PHASE-IN of remote **elementary students** by grade, per building.

Students will return to school about every two weeks or as soon as the building is ready to receive the next grade level. We will continue to monitor/adjust, and we may bring in students in shorter intervals or multiple grades at a time. Students and teachers need to be in the buildings before the M-STEP assessment window.

Please note that your supervisor or building administration will provide additional details, information, and return specifications.

We look forward to seeing you all when you return, in person, to the district. We are STRONGER TOGETHER and will work through this as a STRONG TEAM GRIZZLY!
