

PLEASE READ: IMPORTANT MESSAGE

Bell Times:

Bell times are as follows;


- Morning Bell: 9:20am
 - Doors will not be open until 9:15 for students that are not attending before school care.
- Morning Tardy Bell: 9:35am
 - Any student dropped off after 9:35 must be dropped off at the main entrance and a caregiver MUST sign the student in.
- Afternoon Dismissal: 4:20pm
 - We discourage any early pickups between 3:30 and 4:20. This is an extremely busy time for the classrooms, so unless there is an emergency situation or an appointment that needs to be attended, please wait until 4:20 for all students to be dismissed.

No Early Pick Ups after 3:30pm

We know there may be times when you may need to pick up your child prior to the end of the school day. However, these must be prior to 3:30pm and this should only be rare situations.

End of day procedures are important for students for learning and attendance verification.

Picking up your child early on a regular basis to avoid dismissal times is not allowed.

Bus/Transportation

ESTABROOK AM/PM BUS ROUTES 23/24 (ALWAYS SUBJECT TO CHANGE

The routes will be posted at <u>YCS Transportation Bus Routes</u>. Please take some time to identify the bus your child will be riding. Note as well that the expectation is that kids are at the stop 10 minutes prior to the time indicated on the route sheet.



School Dress Code

Parents are requested to see that children are dressed appropriately for school and weather. Children should wear comfortable clothes to school. <u>During wet, cold weather children should wear boots, mittens, and warm outer clothing.</u>
Shoe boots are not to be worn all day long in school. If boots are worn, please provide another pair of play shoes for use in the classroom. Shoes must also cover toes meaning no slides or sandals. See the district dress code policy below.

BOTTOMS

Pants, shorts, capris, skirts, and dresses must meet all the requirements below:

- Style: Must be worn at the waist and cannot sag.
- Length: Shorts, skirts, and dresses cannot be shorter than the end of the fingertips as the arm is at the side, and cannot drag on the floor.

TOPS

Must meet all the requirements below:

- Style: No vulgar or inappropriate words/graphic designs/logos on tops.
- Fabric: Any fabric with the exception of: translucent material.
- Length: At all times, tops must meet the top of the students' trousers or skirt.
- Neckline: At no time will cleavage be visible.

THE FOLLOWING ARE PROHIBITED:

- Exposed undergarments (except crew-style t-shirt).
- Halter tops, tube tops, tank tops and muscle shirts
- Head gear (caps, hats, sweatbands, bandanas, or scarves, etc.) are not to be worn inside the school building at any time, *exceptions may be made per administration. Hoodies (hoods up) may not be worn in the building.
- Excessively tattered or torn clothing.
- Sunglasses may not be worn in the building at any time.
- Heavy metal chains.
- Slippers/house shoes/slides.
- Jackets must stay in lockers while students are learning.

****Any other item deemed inappropriate by administration****

Any student not in compliance with this dress code will be asked to change his/her clothes, or parents will be contacted to bring appropriate attire. We appreciate your cooperation in keeping Ypsilanti Community Schools a productive learning environment.



Attendance Information

If your student is going to be absent from school, please use our convenient twenty-four-hour absence call-in line 734-221-1900

- Please obtain a doctor's note to receive a medically excused Absence.
- You must call in each day that your child is absent.
- Please call no later than 12:00 p.m. on the day of the absence.
- Students arriving late to school must report to the office to sign in. Parents you <u>HAVE</u> to come inside.
 - We will only allow students to be signed out by people who are listed on the emergency card.
- If you need an in-person meeting with a Principal or with staff, we ask that you please call and make an appointment.
