- ◆ NAAPID or National African American Parent Involvement Day—**POSTERS MUST BE IN IMAGE FORM & UPLOADED**
  - ◆ 2021 Theme or a clear indication of the theme
  - ◆ Illustration of Parent Involvement with Student(s)
  - ◆ Setting: School Environment
  - ◆ African American (Inclusion of other cultures encouraged, optional)
  - ◆ Historical events options, but Parent Involvement with students at/around school must be clearly illustrated.
  - ◆ If entering artwork for a special needs student, please record "POHI" on the back of the poster
  - ◆ Record the following for each student on back of poster
    - ◆ Student name, grade, and age
    - ◆ Name of parent/guardian & email address
    - ◆ Home address & telephone number
    - ◆ Teacher name & email address
