Admissions Process 2024-25

Kindergarten-5th Enrollment Priority

- 1) <u>Sibling Priority</u>-Scholars whose siblings are currently enrolled at YIES, and have a confirmed placement for the requested school year, pending space availability.
- 2) <u>YCS Employee Priority</u>-Scholars whose legal guardian is currently employed by Ypsilanti Community Schools (a lottery will be held if necessary).
- 3) Resident Priority-Scholars who live within the boundaries of Ypsilanti Community Schools (a lottery will be held if necessary).
- 4) <u>School of Choice (SOC)</u>- Scholars who live outside of the boundaries of Ypsilanti Community Schools (a lottery will be held if necessary).

Kindergarten Readiness Assessments for registered incoming kindergarten. This assessment is in-person and by appointment only. Staff will contact accepted applicants to schedule.

Application for 2024-2025 admission closes.
