Kindergarten-5th Enrollment Priority

- 1) <u>Sibling Priority</u>-Scholars whose siblings are currently enrolled at YIES, and has a confirmed placement for the requested school year, pending space availability.
- 2) <u>YCS Employee Priority</u>-Scholars whose legal guardian is currently employed by Ypsilanti Community Schools (a lottery will be held if necessary).
- 3) <u>Resident Priority-</u>Scholars who live within the boundaries of Ypsilanti Community Schools (a lottery will be held if necessary).
- 4) <u>School of Choice (SOC)</u>- Scholars who live outside of the boundaries of Ypsilanti Community Schools (a lottery will be held if necessary).
