


1. To view your grades and attendance by classroom. This is also the default page that loads with the portal.
2. This shows the grades in past years or terms. This is only available for traditional letter grades, not standards.
3. To show attendance across the entire school year in one window.
4. Provides options for what and how often email notifications are sent
5. Allows you to see all of the teacher comments in one place
6. Click to view school wide announcements (if there are any)
7. An optional feature used by high schools for students to request classes.
8. This feature is not used at YCS
9. A view of a student's schedule one week at a time

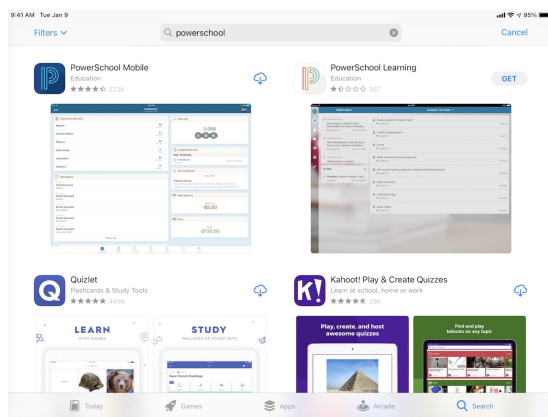
Email Notifications

PowerSchool App on iPad

PowerSchool mobile is an app that can be downloaded on the Apple App Store or the Google Play Store for Android (depending on the version of your mobile device)



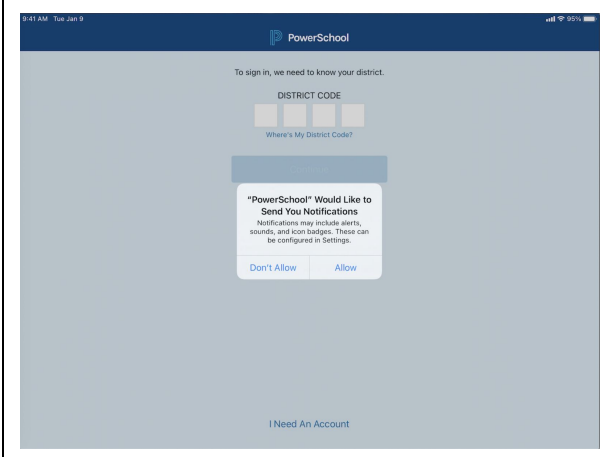
When opening either app store (iOS/Android) search for PowerSchool and make sure to find the blue PowerSchool Mobile icon. That is the program you need.

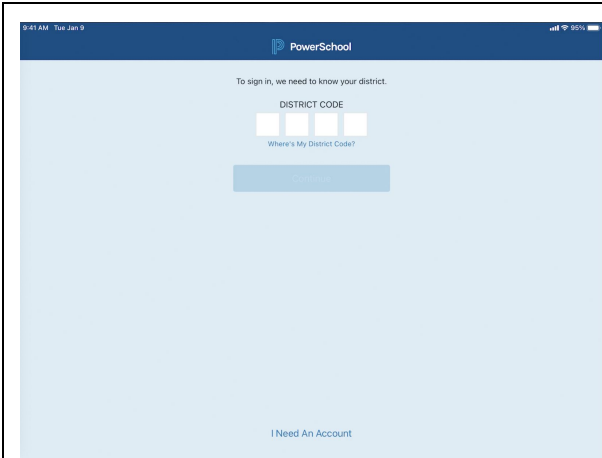


Once you have the app downloaded, you can tap on it to launch the app.



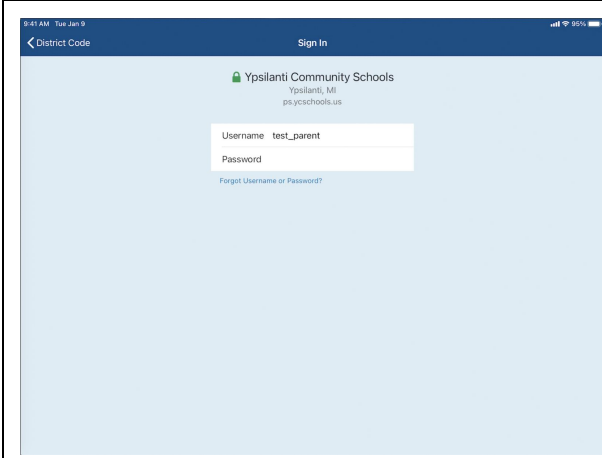
On iOS you will be prompted to allow notifications. These can be controlled later in the app as well, but will give you the notifications you would have received through email such as grade and attendance updates. However, instead of an email, you will get a push notification via the app on your mobile device.

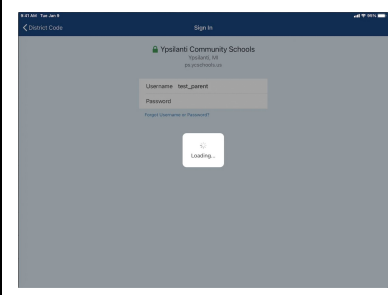


Once you have chosen your preference about notifications you cannot log into your account until you enter the district's 4 digit code. For YCS that is **RLNG**. This code is unique per district and you can only be signed into one district at a time.

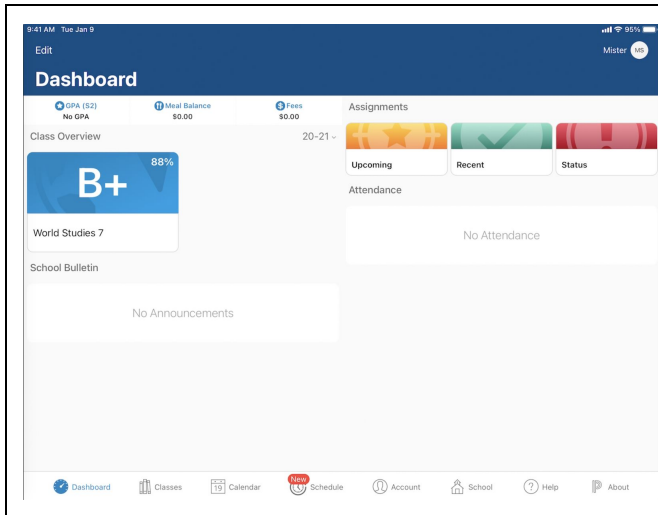
